

## Avenza Maps Commercial Use Amendment

When executed, this document shall serve as an amendment to the Avenza Maps Terms of Use and Service agreement (“the EULA”) to permit commercial use of the Avenza Maps software application (the Products”) by \_\_\_\_\_ (“Licensee”) residing at \_\_\_\_\_, pursuant to the following terms and conditions:

1. Commercial use is limited to a maximum of \_\_\_\_ devices, where a device is any iPhone, iPad, iPod or other piece of electronic hardware capable of running the Products. For the purpose of calculating the number of devices in commercial use pursuant to this document, any device having ever at any time used the Product in a commercial endeavour shall count as one.
2. Paragraph 2(e) of the EULA is hereby amended to permit commercial use of the Products up to a maximum number of devices as specified in paragraph 1 herein.
3. Paragraphs 5(a) and 5(b) are hereby amended to permit commercial use of the Products up to a maximum number of devices as specified in paragraph 1 herein.
4. The term of this amendment shall be from \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ during which all terms herein shall apply. Upon expiration of this amendment it must be extended or renewed pursuant to the terms of the EULA and the prevailing commercial terms of Avenza at that time. If not renewed, or during any period between the expiration hereof and any subsequent renewal, the standard terms of the EULA shall be in full force.
5. If, at any time, commercial use of the Products, pursuant to the EULA and this amendment, exceeds the maximum permitted number of devices as indicated in paragraph 1 of this amendment, Licensee shall immediately inform Avenza accordingly and initiate the purchase of an extended commercial license or immediately reduce the number of devices in commercial use of the Products so as to conform to paragraph 1 herein.
6. All other terms of the EULA shall remain in full force.
